1. The students may consult with their HOD, Mentor, Faculty advisor and give due consideration to the relevance and future prospects while choosing the open elective subject.
2. The Open Elective Subjects opted by the students must neither have been offered earlier in the programme nor have any similarity in the course content of any subject of the programme taught so far.
3. The Open Elective Subjects originating from a department cannot be opted by the students of that department.
4. A subject will not be allowed as Open Elective Subject if the number of students opting for it is less than 30.
5. The classes of Open Elective subjects may comprise of students of more than one branch.
6. Each student is required to submit their choices for maximum three (3) Open Elective subjects in order of their preferences.
7. The classes of all Open elective subjects shall commence on 03.08.20, as per the time table.
8. The allotment of Open Elective subjects shall be made in the basis of CPI of last semester and choice of availability as per the load of the concerned departments.
