Notice regarding postponement of comprehensive examination of Ph. D programme, Admission batch 2018-19

Citing the resolution made by Academic Council on 03.07.2020 as per recommendation of RPIC on 23.06.20 regarding schedule and mode of conduction of comprehensive examination as mentioned below.

Scheduled and mode of conduction of comprehensive examination, Ph. D

Programme, Admission Batch 2018-19

Mode of Conduction: Offline

Tentative schedule: Last week of August 2020

Courses for Comprehensive Examination:

Two subjects from Post Graduate level, he/she studied.

Two subjects from the coursework's, he/she covered.

Question Template for comprehensive Examination (Written):

Time-3hrs, Maximum mark-100, answer all questions

Gr-A (Objective) (10 marks per subject $\times 4 = 40$)*

Each Subject 10 marks $(3\times2 + 2\times2)^*$.

Gr-B (Subjective) (15 marks per subject $\times 4 = 60$)*

One question (may be sub-divided in to two or three parts depending on the weightage of the question) from each Subject.

*The numbers in the brackets suggest marks × number of questions.

It was resolved that unless the situation based on pandemic Covid-19 permits to conduct Comprehensive Examination in offline mode, the students are hereby advised to start the process in referring points (b) & (d) mentioned below.

Following Academic Regulation, a doctoral student, provisionally registered, will be formally registered for the degree of Ph.D. on completion of certain steps. The registration can be done only after (a) the student has successfully completed all assigned course work (b) worked out a road map of his/her doctoral programme (c) successfully cleared the comprehensive examination and (d) delivered an open seminar to the satisfaction of the DAC.

After completion of comprehensive examination and all norms mentioned above in the Academic Regulation, students shall be allowed for confirmation of his registration.

It is to be noted that the date of registration for Ph. D programme shall be effective from the date on which the students deliver a seminar talk in related to his/her topic of Research Work with approval of DAC in consultation with DRC.

The qualifying mark for comprehensive examination is 60% as per Academic norm.

Following the resolution, and based on prevailing situation due to Covid-19, it is hereby notified that the comprehensive examination is postponed till further order and the rescheduled date will be notified subsequently.
