

## NOTIFICATION

### Information Regarding the Process of Examination and Result Publication for the Even Semester: 2019-20

This is for the information of the students of the University that in view of COVID-19 pandemic and subsequent lockdown, it is not considered feasible to conduct the End Semester(Even) Examination for 2019-20 session in the physical mode. Therefore, the University management in tune with the UGC guidelines has decided to conduct the End Semester Examination through the following procedure for all batches of B.Tech/M.Tech/MBA/M.Sc.

#### **Mode of examination and evaluation for all theory subjects:**

The online mode MCQ type examination consists of 30 numbers of questions each carrying one mark (No negative marking). The duration of each examination is one hour. Questions shall be asked from easy, moderate and difficult types proportionately.

#### **Criteria for the award of grade:**

The marks for the award of the final grade shall be taken as per the following norm for all the theory subjects:

The total 100 marks shall be distributed into two components:

➤ **Component 1:** 50 marks in the theory subjects shall be awarded as an average, based on their performance in the last two consecutive semesters/last semester (depending upon the results available). The average mark will be taken from the best grades, secured in 50% of the theory subjects, appeared by the student, in the last two consecutive semesters/last semester.

➤ **Component 2:** The rest 50 marks will be awarded as per the below

#### **Mode of examination and evaluation for all sessional subjects:**

For sessional subjects, including Laboratories, quiz test/viva etc will be conducted in the online video mode using zoom to complete the evaluation. Details of the procedure shall be formulated by the respective departments.



- **Process of the MCQ examination:**


The online exam can be appeared via laptop or mobile, but laptop is preferable. Students will be invited to zoom via the email id by the proctor. Video proctoring will be carried out via zoom and the link of the exam will be shared to the students in the same platform. The students have to complete the online examination within the stipulated time.

A mock examination of the all the students following the above process will be carried out during 25.05.2020 -30.05.2020.

- **Date of examination for B.Tech/MBA/M.Sc/M.Tech: The MCQ type examination for regular and back examinations (For all final year and passout students) of 2<sup>nd</sup>, 4<sup>th</sup>, 6<sup>th</sup> and 8<sup>th</sup> semester will be held during**

**08.06.2020 - 18.06.2020.**
