

**NOTIFICATION**

**Sub:- Information regarding the process of Summer Quarter / Grade Improvement Examination 2019-20.**

This is for the information of the students of the University that in view of COVID-19 pandemic, the University Management in tune with the UGC guidelines has decided to conduct the Summer Quarter Examination 2019-20 through the following procedure for all batches of B.Tech/M.Tech/MBA/M.Sc programmes.

**Mode of Examination and Evaluation for all theory subjects :-**

The online mode MCQ type examination shall be conducted consisting of 30 number of questions each carrying one mark (No negative marking). The duration of each examination is of one hour. Questions shall be asked from easy, moderate and difficult types proportionately.

**Eligible Category:-**

1. Students who were Absent/Debarred in different subjects in both Odd & Even Semesters.
2. Students having Backlog subjects in both Odd & Even Semesters.
3. Students willing to improve their grades that they obtained in even sem End Examination 2019 – 20.
4. All the above categories of students shall be allowed to appear the examination, subject to clearance of institutional dues.

**The Re-internal Examination for debarred students will be conducted by respective Departments before the commencement of the Summer Quarter Examination.**

**Criteria for the award of grade:-**

The marks for the award of the final grade shall be taken as per the following norms for all the theory subjects:-

The total 100 marks shall be distributed into two components:-

- > **Component 1 :-** 50 marks in the theory subjects shall be awarded as an average, based on their performance in the previous semester(s) (depending upon the results available). The average mark will be taken from the best grades, secured in 50% of the theory subjects, appeared by the students, in the previous semester(s). However for students whose marks are not available for any of the previous semesters under the above criteria, this 50 marks of such student shall be equal to the exact mark obtained in component 2.
- > **Component 2 :-** Rest of the marks will be awarded as mentioned below:-
  - Teachers Assessment (TA) - 10
  - Assignments/Quiz/Viva etc - 10
  - MCQ Exam (Online mode) - 30

### **Mode of Examination and evaluation for all sessional subjects :-**

For sessional subjects, including laboratories, quiz test/viva, etc will be conducted in the online video mode to complete the evaluation. Details of the procedure shall be formulated by the respective Departments.

- **Process of the MCQ Examination :-**

The online exam can be appeared via laptop or mobile, but laptop is preferable. Students will be invited to virtual platform via the email id by the invigilator. Video proctoring will be carried out via virtual mode and the link of the exam will be shared to the students in the same platform. The students have to complete the online examination within the stipulated time.

- **Date of Examination for B.Tech/MBA/M.Tech/M.Sc:-**

The MCQ type online examination for Summer Quarter examinations for 1st year, 2nd year, 3rd year & 4th year students will be held from **01.09.2020\*** to **19.09.2020\***.

**\*The dates may be revised as per the COVID-19 guidelines issued by the Govt. time to time.**

**Note:**

1. The students desirous of improving their grades of the even semester examination 2019 – 20 which was conducted through Online mode will be allowed to appear in this examination. For such students, 70 marks (Component 1, TA 10 & Quiz/Viva etc. 10) will remain the same as obtained from the even semester examination 2019 – 20. Students may register for improvement of grade through Google link- <https://forms.gle/2jLmDranZbR9Mw4MA> from **21.08.2020 to 25.08.2020**.
2. Students are allowed to appear the grade improvement examination once only.
3. The grades shall be awarded to the debarred students as per our existing regulation.
4. There shall be no 2<sup>nd</sup> phase SQ examination.
