Sub.: Central Sector Scholarship Scheme of "Top Class Education for SC category students" through NSP Portal.

Govt. of India (The Ministry of Social Justice & Empowerment) came out with a Central Sector Scholarship Scheme for Top class education for SC students to re-look at the critical gaps in quality education and drafted a more liberal scholarship scheme which can take care of the quality education for the above category students. The scholarship once awarded, will continue for the completion of the course subject to satisfactory performance. **Top 10 SC students** will be selected for Top Class Education Scholarship. Selection will be made in the basis of Annual family Income of the students and Inter-se-ranking of the institution.

Eligibility:

- Those SC & ST students who have taken admission in the institution in the 1st year, B. Tech. Course in 2021-22.
- The total annual family income of the students to be eligible for this scholarship from all sources should not exceed **Rs.8.00 lakh** per annum.
- The scholarship will be terminated if the student fails to pass the final examination of each year or any terminal examination or semester examination prescribed. He will, however, remain eligible for the Post-Matric Scholarship.

Benefits:

- Full Tuition fee amount (yearly) and non-refundable charges
- Living expenses @Rs. 3000/- per month
- Books and stationery @ Rs. 5000/- per year
- A latest Computer/laptop of reputed brand with accessories like UPS and Printer limited to Rs. 45,000/-.

Students belonging to the above category are required to register and apply for the above scholarship through National e-Scholarship Portal (NeSP) **www.scholarships.gov.in on or before 30-11-2021** and report to the DSW office immediately for verification and further processing with the following documents.

- Copy of last academic record (attested)
- Copy of Aadhaar Card
- Front page of Bank passbook (self attested)
