The students are required to adhere to the following guidelines while choosing Open Elective Subjects:

1. The students are required to choose their Open Elective subjects on or before **10.01.2022 through Google form**, failing which they are bound to abide by the decision of Dean Academics on this matter.
2. The students may consult with their HOD, Mentor, Faculty advisor and give due consideration to the relevance and future prospects while choosing the open elective subject.
3. While filling the choice for Open Elective Subjects for 8th Semester, the students need to follow the following guidelines, strictly:
 - a. *Should not have the same subject as Open Elective in the 7th Semester*
 - b. *Should not have studied similar/same subject either as core subject or programme elective subject in earlier semester.*
 - c. *Repetition of subject will lead to non completion of B. Tech Programme. In such cases students may have to repeat a different Open Elective during Summer Quarter.*
4. The Open Elective Subjects originating from a department cannot be opted by the students of that department.
5. If the number of students opting for a subject is less than 30, then that subject will not be offered as an open elective.
6. In each open elective subject, maximum 120 students will be allowed on the basis of CGPA and the order of preference submitted by the students.
7. The classes of Open Elective subjects may comprise of students of more than one branch.
8. Each student is required to submit their choices for maximum five (5) open elective subjects in order of their preferences.
