The students are required to adhere to the following guidelines while choosing Open Elective Subjects:

- 1. The Open Elective Subjects opted by the students must neither have been offered earlier in the programme nor have any similarity in the course content of any subject (**Core/Programme Elective Subjects**) of the programme taught so far.
- 2. The students are required to choose their Open Elective subjects on or before **30.12.23 through Google form,** failing which they are bound to abide by the decision of Dean Academics on this matter.
- 3. The students may consult with their HOD, Mentor, Faculty advisor and give due consideration to the relevance and future prospects while choosing the open elective subject.
- 4. The Open Elective Subjects originating from a department cannot be opted by the students of that department.
- 5. If the number of students opting for a subject is less than 30, then that subject will not be offered as an open elective.
- 6. In each open elective subject, maximum 120 students will be allowed on the basis of CGPA and the order of preference submitted by the students.
- 7. The classes of Open Elective subjects may comprise of students of more than one branch.
- 8. Each student is required to submit their choices for maximum five (5) open elective subjects in order of their preferences.
