Rules:

- The tournament will be held as per ICC rules.
- The tournament will be played on knockout basis.
- For match no. 1 to 4 will be played 12 overs a side and match no. 5 to 7 will be played 15 overs a side.
- There will be three power plays. The power play of 12 over match will be 3-7-2 and for 15 over match will be 4-8-3.
- The on-field umpire decision is final. If any team found to be involved in any in-disciplinary act, then the team will be suspended.
- Teams have to report to the ground at least 15 minutes before the schedule time or else other team will be declared as winner.
- For 12 and 15 over matches each team has to complete their bowling quota within 1Hr. and 1Hr. 15mnts. Respectively. Otherwise penalty will be imposed on the bowling team.
