Duties and responsibilities of the Anti-Ragging Squad:

- To maintain constant vigilance, supervision, and patrolling across the institution. The Squad shall remain mobile, alert, and active at all times to prevent incidents of ragging.
- To conduct surprise visits to hostels and other locations that are vulnerable to ragging or have the potential for such incidents. The Squad shall inspect these areas regularly. To ensure effective vigilance, the Head of the Squad may, if necessary, submit a written request to the Chairman of the Anti-Ragging Committee for the inclusion of additional members in the Squad.
- To conduct on-the-spot inquiries into any incident of ragging referred to it by the Head of the Institution, any member of the faculty, any member of the staff, any student, parent or guardian, employee of a service provider, or any other person, as the case may be.
- To submit an inquiry report, along with its findings and recommendations, to the Anti-Ragging Committee for appropriate action. While conducting such inquiries, the Anti-Ragging Squad shall ensure a fair, impartial, and transparent procedure in accordance with the principles of natural justice. The Squad shall provide the student(s) accused of ragging, as well as other concerned witnesses, with adequate opportunity to present the relevant facts, documents, and their views regarding the incident. The Squad shall also take into consideration any other relevant information deemed necessary before submitting its report.
